The Direct Debit Guarantee



- This Guarantee is offered by all Banks and Building Societies that accept instructions to pay Direct Debits.
- If there are any changes to the amount, date or frequency of your Direct Debit the Motor Neurone Disease Association will notify you 10 working days in advance of your account being debited or as otherwise agreed. If you request the Motor Neurone Disease Association to collect a payment, confirmation of the amount and date will be given to you at the time of the request.
- If an error is made in the payment of your Direct Debit by the Motor Neurone Disease Association or your Bank or Building Society you are entitled to a full and immediate refund of the amount paid from your Bank or Building Society. If you receive a refund you are not entitled to, you must pay it back when the Motor Neurone Disease Association asks you to.
- You can cancel a Direct Debit at any time by simply contacting your Bank or Building Society. Written confirmation may be required. Please also notify us.

Using Gift Aid means that for every pound you give, we get an extra 25 pence from HM Revenue and Customs, helping your donation go further.

This means that £10 can be turned into £12.50 as long as donations are made through Gift Aid. Imagine what a difference that could make, and it doesn't cost you a thing.

So if you want your donation to go further, Gift Aid it. Just complete your name and address details below.

Gift Aid Declaration

I am a UK taxpayer and would like the MND Association to treat all donations I have made in the past four years or I make in future as Gift Aid donations.
